

# INCOME TAX EMPLOYEES FEDERATION ANDHRA PRADESH & TELENGANA CIRCLE

Dear Comrades,

You are all aware that the Confederation of Central Government Employees and Workers (CCGEW), New Delhi has called for a **one day strike** on 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2015 in pursuit of our long pending demands. A detailed circular in this regard was also given by the ITEF, AP & TS Circle on 12.08.2015.

Comrades, ever since the formation of confederation, the ITEF is playing leading role in all its agitations and become the torch bearer for confederation. The present strike call was given against the pro-capitalist and anti-employee policies of Government. The charter of demand consists demands like curtailing price rise, lifting of ceiling on compassionate appointments, lifting of ceiling on Bonus, scrapping of New Pension Scheme (NPS), filling up all vacant posts and stopping privatization/outsourcing etc.,. All these demands have direct bearing on every employee and their fulfillment will greatly improve our living/working conditions.


Comrades, the Government showed its anti-employee stand again with extension of date of submission of 7<sup>th</sup> pay commission report upto 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2015. As per its terms of reference, the pay commission should submit its report before 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2015 and its recommendation are effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2016. With the extension of time for submission of its report, the implementation of pay commission recommendations will invariably postponed. Even though the Government keeps the date of effect at 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2016, the allowances such as HRA, Transport Allowance might be given from the date of acceptance of report not from date effect, as happened in 6<sup>th</sup> pay commission. It is nothing but back stabbing the employees. The recommendation of the 6<sup>th</sup> pay commission were implemented w.e.f 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2006 whereas benefits such as HRA, Transport Allowance were given prospectively i.e, from 01.09.2008, causing great loss to the employees. It may not be surprising, if the present Government also follow the above trend.

Comrades, unless we fight hard and demonstrate our united strength, the Government may not relent from such anti-employee, anti-poor stand. Already all the central trade unions including INTUC and BMS, the employees of transport sector including even auto rickshaw unions announced their support to the strike call given by the confederation on 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2015. It may be noted that, **the Income Tax Gazetted Officers Association (ITGOA) is also participating in the strike and this will greatly strengthen our cause. Therefore, it is once again requested to make the all India strike on 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2015 a grand success. All the comrades are requested to come to office on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2015 only, once you leave the office on the evening of 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2015**
