Dear Comrade,

This is to bring to your notice that the Chairman CBDT had a meeting with leaders of ITEF Central Headquarters on 27.09.2011 wherein all the pending demands were discussed. On the issue of filling up on vacancies, necessary instructions to all Cadre controlling authorities have been issued to report the vacancies at the earliest, to fill up the vacancies. Regarding timely holding of DPCs for promotions to all cadres, the Chairman assured that instructions will be given to all CCAs to issue adhoc promotions wherever DPCs are held up due to litigations, subject to review on final judicial verdict. Regarding cadre restructure, it was informed that the Board has recently submitted it's reply to various queries raised by the DoPT. Regarding other issues, namely, financial benefit on promotions to the cadre of OS and Steno Gr.I, restoring the scheme of special pay to various cadres, advance increments on passing examinations, cadre composition proposals and functioning of CPCs, a high level committee has been formed to sort out the differences and recommend ways and means **within a month**. The committee will be headed by Shri Manoj Joshi, DI(HRD) and three members from ITEF, viz., Com K.P. Rajgopal, President, Com. Ashok Salunkhe, Secretary General, Com. Rupak Sarkar, Finance Secretary. In view of the above, the Central Headquarters has decided to defer the agitation program.

Comrades, I take this opportunity to also inform you that one of our leaders, Com V.S.R. Krishna is retiring today. He worked as General Secretary of AP Circle for a long period and also worked as all India President of ITEF. He is presently retiring as Administrative Officer. On the day of retirement, it becomes our duty to come together, join hands, and bid farewell to an illustrious leader of this organization. On behalf of ITEF, AP Circle, I take this opportunity to thank him for the services rendered to the organization in various capacities and wish him all the very best in the future.
